

What was accomplished during this coaching visit?	I had the opportunity to observe four grade-level collaboratives. The campus principal has done an outstanding job of providing data for all grade levels including reading levels, math data, subpopulations, and student progress. This was some of the most extensive data I have seen. • Kindergarten: Discussion around next essential learning target; K.6 identifying character, setting, main events, and solutions to a piece of dramatic literature • 1st Grade: Identified students who needed more support using the skill and will quadrant chart • 2nd Grade: Discussion on essential standards that need to be revisited from the year. Looked at third grade TEKS and STAAR question stems for a better understanding of what students will need for third grade • 3rd Grade: Shared interim data and best teaching practices
Do you have any issues, concerns, or hurdles that you will be working on in future coaching visits?	This performing campus and teachers are willing to please. Many of the practices are in place however there needs to be some refinement in the work. Would like to see more work unwrapping the essential standards with the teams, pacing, and determining what proficiency will look like for students.
What are your next steps for your next visit?	I will work with vertical teams for grades 4-6 th after school. The principal has asked me to review unwrapping standards and pacing at my next visit.
What homework did you leave the school to focus on until your next visit?	 Kindergarten: Unwrapping essential learning standards, pacing, and determining what proficiency will be 1st Grade: Decide what strategies students will need to increase their skills for the unit and how to provide motivational goals for those who weren't willing to do the work 2nd Grade: I'm very encouraged by the thinking of this team and how to support students. One area mentioned that one team member creates all the LA plans for the team. I will need more clarification on this next visit 3rd Grade: Creating CFA assessments during the unit
